


DIRECTIONS TO PERRY/WILLARD WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

The Perry/Willard Wastewater Treatment Plant is located 45 miles north of Salt Lake City via Interstate 15. The interstate exit is #357, same exit as for Willard Bay State Park North Marina. Follow Route 315 (750 North) under Interstate 15 to the west side. First intersection is the Frontage Road, go north along Frontage Road for approximately 0.3 miles to an intersection and turn right (north). Road travels alongside lagoons, treatment plant is immediately north of lagoons.



DIRECTIONS TO JAMES C. HANSEN EDUCATION CENTER, BEAR RIVER MIGRATORY BIRD REFUGE

The Bear River Migratory Bird Refuge is located 50 miles north of Salt Lake City via Interstate 15. The interstate exit is #363 (Forest Street) in Brigham City. The Education Center is on Forest Street one block west of Interstate 15.
